- IL Services That Have Been Provided Since 13 or Date in Care (Earliest)
- Includes Appropriate IL & Transition Services
- Served on All Parties 65C-28.009(6)(H)I

- Referrals Made
- Adoption: Documentation of Steps for Permanent Placement (the Department)

### Child Has or Understands

- How to Access Courts
- Notification of RTI, Aftercare & Transitional Support
  - Eligibility, Application Forms & Assistance
- Waivers, Scholarships, Grants, Medical Assistance
- Child has a Mentor
- Medicaid Card & Information
- Certified Copy of Birth Certificate
- Florida ID or Driver's License
- Full Accounting of Master Trust Account, if Applicable
- Budgeting Skills Training
- Interviewing Skills Training
- Open Bank Account or ID Necessary
- Banking Skills Training
- Information About Public Assistance & How to Apply

### Normalcy § 409.1451(3)(a); 65C-30.007(10)

- Written Plan Developed
- Review Normalcy Plan – Quarterly
- Given Information: Drug & Alcohol, Runaway Prevention, Health Services, Available Resources, Legal Issues
- Permission/ Encouragement for:
  - Social / Extracurricular Activities

- Contact W/Family Members, if Appropriate
- Access to Phone
- Reasonable Curfews
- Assistance in Participating in Activities Such as:
  - Driver's Ed/Support Effort to Get Auto Insurance
  - Public Recognition for Accomplishments
  - Community & School Organizations Clubs
- No One Can Take Away Normalcy Plan Activities as Punishment

**Placement**

- May Remain in Current Placement after 18, if Eligible for RTI § 409.1451(5)(b)(5)d
- Stability, "Family-Like" Appropriate

**Education/Career Plan § 409.1450(3)(b) Age 13+**

- Reviewed at Each JR
- Post Secondary Goal Established
- Course Requirements, GPA, Courses Necessary, Mentor
- In Writing, Signed by Child, Teacher or School Staff Member Shall be Involved in Development
- Child Can Change Goal any Time & Receive Updated Educational Plan

**Financial**

- Master Trust ~ Quarterly Accounting Attached to JR
  - Personal Allowance – No Less Than \$15 a Month
  - Notice of Ability to Request Fee Waiver or Change in Foster Care or Personal Allowance 65C-17.005
  - Funds to be Distributed at Discharge?
  - Change Payee to Child or Special Needs Trust § 402.17(7)
- Foster Care Allowance - Part of Board Rate Sent to Foster Parents

**Developmental Disability**

- Disability Services Applied for / Receiving Before 18

**Minor Parents 65C-31.005(11) F.A.C.**

- Same Access to Services, IL Services, Plan for Future, Child Placed with Minor (Unless at "Significant Risk") 65C-28.010(1)

**Department Has Not Complied With Case Plan or IL Services Required §39.701(6)(c)**

- Court Shall Issue a Show Cause Order
- 30 Days if Cause Shown, if not then Contempt

**Court Order**

- Received Disability of Non-Age Order – Given to Child (residential/banking)
- Issues with Court Order That Require Follow-Up

**Follow-Up**

- Discussed Follow-Up Issues /Developed Plan / Motions
- Any Possible Appellate Issues?
